Dear Friends,

Thank you for your support and prayers. I love sharing what God is doing in the ministry. This past weekend, I was able to share a ministry update with Temple Church in Gypsum, KS. They asked, "What specific ways are you currently seeing God at work in the ministry?" We receive letters from our students telling us how much the lessons mean to them. They look forward to studying the Bible in a systematic way. The Lord is working in their lives and the Bible lessons are a key part in that process. However, it isn't often that I'm able to tell of people impacted by the jail ministry.

Recently, a woman wrote in explaining that she had worshipped several deities. She was in a relationship with an abuser and to protect her children, she reported him. Through that process, she found herself in jail. One day, John gave her a Bible. She turned to Matthew 6 and read. Then she listened as John spoke and when he told them to turn to Matthew 6, she knew that God was reaching out to her. She went back to her cell and cried, calling upon the name of the Lord. Her testimony states that all those deities she worshipped, didn't hear her, but God did. He turned her around. She is in the process of taking lessons from us. Someday, she wants to help others like John helped her -- by telling them about the Lord. God is using John and other chaplains to meet with men and women to point them to Jesus. We are praising the Lord for His goodness.

Chaplains have become a great source to help us get the lessons into different facilities. In the past, I've mentioned Ray who goes into the Cherokee County facility in Tahlequah. He takes our lessons into the jail because they do not allow mail. Many jails are having to stop mail from coming in due to drugs. I spoke to the Grady county sheriff a few weeks ago and discovered that there are people sending drug-soaked paper into the facility using existing ministry papers that they copy. It is a terrible problem. That is why we seek chaplains who will work with us. We are also working on finding the best way to get the courses that we publish online. But we have a few needs:

- 1. A platform (website or app) that the students can access with the tablets given to them by the facility.
- 2. A person who can put our courses in the format needed for the platform.
- 3. Funds to pay for the courses to be housed on the platform. One app called Edovo charges \$1500 for 50 lessons. At this point, I've only researched that app. There is another called Pando. There may be others that we can

Please pray for this project which I'm calling "Project 2026." The goal is to have at least one course accessible by the end of 2026. Not only will it take God's direction, but it will take prayer and partners to accomplish.


